Judge Farrar opened a work session of the Gilliam County Court at 10:30 a.m. at Condon High School, Condon, Oregon. Present were Judge Elizabeth Farrar, Commissioner Leslie Wetherell, Commissioner Sherrie Wilkins, and Court Administrative Assistant Teresa Aldrich.

IN THE MATTER OF FACILITY TOUR AND REPORT ON CONDON SCHOOL DISTRICT CAPITAL INVESTMENT GRANT PROJECTS

Condon School Superintendent Geer reviewed with the Court some of the previous capital investment grant projects that have been completed, which include new flooring in some classrooms, gym bleachers, siding on shop, and exterior painting. Current projects include replacing the HVAC system, which will take place this summer. Future projects for consideration may include partial roof replacement, athletic locker rooms, restrooms, classroom remodel and relocation to accommodate the addition of the 7th and 8th Graders. Jeff Schott from Pillar Consulting was also on hand to answer questions.

The Court toured the school and witnessed firsthand the completion of past projects, and the areas of possible future capital projects. Superintendent Geer also showed the Court the new grade school construction site and said the school district is hoping to break ground spring of 2021.

Judge Farrar adjourned the work session at 11:15 a.m.
