JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Gilliam County Sheriff's Office has an opening for a Criminal/Traffic Enforcement Deputy in Gilliam County, OR. Minimum requirements are as follows: must be at least 21 years of age and a U.S. citizen, must have or be able to obtain from the Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training with preference given to Basic Certified and Advanced level of certification, a minimum of a High School diploma or equivalent, with preference given to applicants with higher education, the successful passing of any combination of written, oral and psychological tests and a background investigation and medical examination, the possession of a valid Oregon Driver's License, and no criminal record. The successful applicant will demonstrate high moral character, and the ability to perform under stress and within a paramilitary management system. Residency requirement to live within Gilliam County, specifically, Arlington, Oregon.

Gilliam County offers a competitive salary and benefits package, including participation in the Oregon Public Employees Retirement System. The minimum base salary for this position will start at \$52,000 with consideration for certification levels.
